The show site is in the orchard, a park-like setting adjacent to Charlie Clark's, one of Pinetop's favorite restaurants. Live music, food and drink encourage patrons to linger under the tall pines.

The High Country Art Association, a non-profit, all volunteer organization dedicated to supporting the visual arts in the White Mountains, organizes the Festival. Our purpose is to showcase creative, original art and fine crafts. A lively Silent Auction helps fund HCAA's Art Education programs in the community. Donations from participating artists are greatly appreciated.

Festival Location	The Orchard at Charlie Clark's, 1701 E. White Mtn. Boulevard., Pinetop, AZ
Applications	Applications may be submitted by mail or email.
Artwork	This is a juried show. All artworks must be of original design and executed by the exhibitor. Entries are limited by category. No CBD products.
Acceptance	Notification will be made via email after the jury process is complete. Checks will be deposited, and credit cards charged upon acceptance. Application materials are not returned.
Cancellation Policy	This is a "rain or shine" show. There are no refunds. The space fee may be credited to a future show at the discretion of the Festival Committee.
Space Details	Many spaces are located under huge trees and may be on uneven ground. Space assignments are based on exhibit flow. There is no electricity.
Display	Tents must be white and weighted. Tables draped to the ground.
City Permit	A Pinetop-Lakeside vendor permit is required for all exhibitors. You are responsible for obtaining the permit.
Security	Security personnel will be on-site overnight, however, HCAA assumes no liability for artists' property.
